Reading and Writing

We are moving onto the Letter Pp and the book Paper Party. The children are masters at predicting what will happen in a story. We love to look through the pictures before we read to see if we can figure out what choices a character will make, or how the story will end. This is a fun way to get the students interested in reading. It is also helpful when they are looking at their own books before they can read all of the words. They are able to get involved in the story!

Please continue to practice the letters we have learned in class at home (l, o ,g, h, t, p). Point them out in your reading, practice the sounds in the car, or name an animal and let your child figure out which letter the animal name starts with. These are all fun ways to engage your child in learning more about their letters and sounds!
